In 2011 i founded a tech organization in Alexandria University to take care about Robotics and to involve more students in this field to enhance the market with qualified fresh graduates, the organization had a great progress through these 3 years, in 2014 we were qualified to represent Egypt three times in different competitions in less than 6 months (two times in India and one in USA). In 2013 i worked for Nahdet Elmahrousa as a student ambassador in Alexandria, i was responsible for the marketing and awareness about Young Innovators program in Alexandria. In 2012 i worked for a year in High level students -NGO- which manage many events in different fields (charity, scientific, visits,,etc) , i was here responsible for the Public relations and fund raising. In 2013 i participated in formula students germany, i was responsible for the electrical team management and fund raising, we designed and fabricated a formula race car and participated in the competition in Germany. In 2014 i participated in the first Egypt-Japan workshop on practical education for Mechatronics and Robotics at Egypt-Japan University for science and technology.

i asked some friends who have practical experience with many companies, i told them that i am searching for a position in which i be able to add value to the employer and in the same time i can enhance my abilities and gain more experience, i am in need for a position that can improve my teamwork skills, project management skills, communication and presentation skills, i am searching for an opportunity in which i can be effective and it can be a good start for my career, my friends recommended some companies and my choice was Unilever as i see with hard work in a small position as a start or a trainee i can help Unilever reach its goals and i can be effective, and also Unilever is a great company in which i can improve my skills and get a suitable opportunity for my career after graduation

2. Using an example of a time when you were in a new environment and had to achieve a task, please describe a) how you established and used a network of contacts, and b) how you set about influencing people, to help you achieve your task. (500 word limit imposed) *

In January 2014 my position was chairman and technical mentor for two teams of second year students , the two teams were about to participate in International robotics challenge competition, there were three steps of filtration and they reached the finals and the two teams were qualified to represent Egypt in the international competition in India. the problem was that we have only three weeks for the international competition, no time to finish our official papers, we have no money to cover the traveling expenses for the teams, and also the time of the competition was in the same time with the final exams. In this problem i had to manage a perfect plan for the fund raising in less than one week, i had to help my two teams with their technical work , i had to work in some official papers to postpone the exams, and also search for some offers for cheap flights, and the important thing is to keep my team members inspired. I started to divide my team members into some sub-teams and i managed with them a suitable plans for our problems, the fund raising team asked all the members for contacts and they contacted them to ask for a sponsorship and after 10 days we got a sponsorship that covered all our expenses, another team was responsible for discussing the exams timing with our faculty, they worked for 5 days and they failed to postpone the exams so they asked for the help of their class, all students in their class accepted to postpone the exams to let our teams represent Egypt in IRC, another team was responsible for searching for cheap offers for tickets, and in parallel each sub-team was given some technical tasks to modify our robots, finally all our problems were solved.

3. Tell us about an occasion when you have taken the initiative to learn and develop yourself in significantly new ways. Why did you want to do this, what did you do and what was the result?(300 word limit imposed) *

in my first year i joined Alexandria university motorsports team as the youngest member in the team, all the members were last year students, they accepted me through three interviews, this team is a technical one but there was no technical interviews, they expected that i can help them with the electrical work and i was still in my first year and don't know much about the automotive engineering, and in the same time it was a great chance for me to improve my technical skills, but i have to prove that i can be effective in the team, i read 3 books in the field of automotive engineering and finished an online course and i became one of the most effective members in the team and after that in 2013 i was the electrical team head.

4. Tell us about a time when you saw the opportunity to really make a difference for the future of an activity, team or organization. What did you do, what obstacles did you overcome, and what happened as a result? (300 word limit imposed) *

in 2011 i was in my first year and i was interested in Robotics but there weren't any activity related to robotics in Alexandria University, i asked my friends to link me with anyone who has the same interests and with 10 students we founded a technical organization in Alexandria University. our aim was to involve more students in the field of robotics to establish a new

professional robotics careers in Egypt. there were many problems in the start, there were no money, no one believes in what we do and no one can imagine that we can improve the professional market of robotics in Egypt starting from here. now in 2014 i am holding the chairman position of this organization which now has 50 active member, 5 technical mentors, 7 sub-teams, represented Egypt in international competitions and events three times, represented Alexandria in regional competitions 8 times, total budget exceeded 150,000 Egyptian pound. in 2016 50 fresh graduate will be ready to go on the robotics development in Egypt and in 2017 there will be more.

5. Tell us about a time when you have had to analyse and understand a complex situation in order to make decisions and put a plan into action. What did you do and what was the outcome? (300 word limit imposed) *

In 2013 i was a part of Alexandria University motorsports and we had to travel to Germany in August to present the car we made, and at the same time i was a part of another team that has a competition in September. the team leader of September's competition told me that the team needs my work and he prefer to stay with them this time i have to spend in Germany, and in the same time the other team already booked me a ticket to Germany. i was in a big conflict what should i do in this situation i have to stay in the place in which i will be more effective but it will be hard to tell the other team that i won't be able to be with you this period, i studied the timeline of the two teams carefully and i found that the team which is going to Germany doesn't have any work to be done there, we have to travel just to celebrate our work and to be evaluated from the international judges, so i found that its better to stay in Egypt to work with the other team, and the result was that i worked with the two teams and i did all my tasks and i led them to a great progress but i sacrificed with my flight to Germany and i paid the expenses of my ticket.
