Ever since school we have been encouraged by teachers to enhance our leadership skills as well as seek a career path that would truly reflect our high abilities and bring out our potentials. During my college education, I have been trying to identify the specialty, where I could be beneficial the most. I do so by constantly taking advice from my professors, attend sessions and workshops in various specialties and apply to internships such as this one to experience real world applications.

2. Using an example of a time when you were in a new environment and had to achieve a task, please describe a) how you established and used a network of contacts, and b) how you set about influencing people, to help you achieve your task. (500 word limit imposed) *

In September 2011, I was responsible for planning and organizing a cultural themed event for the youth initiative I was working in. With the help of a contact, we managed to book a suitable place for the event, and with the help of teamwork, we managed to supply the right material, create workshops and activities from scratch and both influence as well as entertain 120 volunteers. Worthy of mentioning that 2 days before the event, I faced a street robbery just in front of the event as I was going to pay for the reservation. That's where the owners showed a lot of tolerance and re-negotiated the price, and that's where the power of influence and teamwork appeared as the organizing team managed to compensate for the lost money and still hold the event.

About one and a half years ago, I started taking online courses from prestigious international universities and self educate myself in different fields from my education specialty.

During our main semester project for the Control Systems subject, we were working on a car prototype showing many of the modern car applications using sensors. One night prior to the project delivery and while connecting the project for the last time, the main Bluetooth sensor and microcontroller were burned. Some team members were negatively affected by the incident and were despaired. Unconsciously, I believed we should get up, get a new sensor and re-wire the project with a different controller. The discussion went good the other day and I was made aware that my positive attitude really helped.

In 2012, I was part of a civil project called Model European Union, hosted by Bib.Alex. Participants showed great results and the council was a success.
