1. Please tell us about experiences and people that have over time shaped your decision to consider a management career within Unilever and in your chosen function in particular. What efforts have you made to test out your choices?(300 word limit imposed) *

Last November I participated in "The Quest- by Unilever" i was really inspired by Unilever's mission "Small actions big difference". This mission was reflected throughout the competition. Each small brick added by a passionate employee makes a country of 400 brands in 180 countries. Participating in the competition gave me the chance to explore other career paths. Seeing the passionate employees who come from different educational backgrounds changed my career plans. I would choose a job that adds value to me and to the

society rather than a job based on my major. I would like to work for a company that positively empowers the society, improves the economy and transforms the environment. Last but not least, the experience helped me in prioritizing the things I will be looking for in a job. For example, a working environment that is built on trust, respect and passion would be a great one to work in. Working in such an environment would encourage me to work for the best.

2. Using an example of a time when you were in a new environment and had to achieve a task, please describe a) how you established and used a network of contacts, and b) how you set about influencing people, to help you achieve your task. (500 word limit imposed) *

Two years ago I was chosen as The Dynamic Public relations Head in the Cairo International Model of Arab League (CIMAL). I was the youngest head and my experience was limited. My job was to contact keynote speakers for CIMAL's various events, manage a team of 18 members, reach for schools and universities to get delegates and execute CIMAL's off campus PR. At the beginning i was overwhelmed by the responsibility but knowing that i was responsible for the image of an organization that has been there for 23 years i was determined to work hard. Setting clear goals and motivating the members working with me where the main pillars towards breaking records. From day one all the members were involved in goal setting. I arranged trainings for the members from CIMAL's alumni which increased the members' passion to the club. I was capable of influencing my members through setting clear goals, motivating them and making sure i am there whenever needed. Together with my members we were able to reach Secretary General Nabil Al Araby, recruit 1200 delegates from 5 different universities, 120 junior delegates from various schools and 20 international delegates.

3. Tell us about an occasion when you have taken the initiative to learn and develop yourself in significantly new ways. Why did you want to do this, what did you do and what was the result?(300 word limit imposed) *

As part of the actuarial profession you have to sit for 5 exams to be a licensed associate. These exams require a lot of independent studying. I always had the fear of sitting for these exams and i was planning to postpone them. However, last summer I took my first Actuarial Exam. I studied for this exam during the summer. Studying independently was a difficult because i did not know whether i was on the right track or not. But I searched the internet for extra material and asked for guidance from students who took this exam before. In August i passed my Financial Mathematics exam with a high grade. In addition last March i passed my second actuarial exam (Probability exam) which i was studying to together with the university's work load.

Studying at AUC i always felt that there was something missing in the community development and charitable organizations at AUC. There is competition between such organizations when they should be completing each other. Together with a group of friends we founded " Mashrou3 Kheir" with the vision of making Kheir as a lifestyle. Our aim is to bring all community development and charity projects to volunteers so they can direct their skills to the best cause. To start up this organization we had to overcome a lot of university restrictions. Because we believed in the cause of such an organization we started operating off campus. It was really a successful model which made the university's approval easier.

Reaching the second stage of "The Quest- By Unilever" we were given a business case to solve in teams of 5. At the beginning it was difficult to understand what was required.
