1. Please tell us about experiences and people that have over time shaped your decision to consider a management career within Unilever and in your chosen function in particular. What efforts have you made to test out your choices?(300 word limit imposed) *

In high school, I was fascinated by the field of Computer Science but did not really want to pursue a career in programming. Before entering college, I met an AUC student who talked to me about the major of Management of Information Technology that integrates the business and IT functions of a business. That's when I decided to join the program. I believed it would make me learn a lot about computer science and give me proper business skills at the same time. This semester, I am taking an Operations Management course. The subject is far from being easy. However, I found it to be very interesting. I believe that Forecasting, Supply Chain and Inventory Management, Cost-Benefit Analysis, Capacity planning and related topics are key functions to guarantee the success of a business, as they are really quantifiable and reliable. Choosing to work at Unilever was based on the reputation of the company rather than on specific people or experiences. Being one of the largest multinational companies in the world, it can teach me a lot regarding one of the two fields chosen.

2. Using an example of a time when you were in a new environment and had to achieve a task, please describe a) how you established and used a network of contacts, and b) how you set about influencing people, to help you achieve your task. (500 word limit imposed) *

During the sessions of the International Conference on Global Economy, my co-Secretariats and I were asked to design a joint session between the councils from which the delegates could learn while having fun. We called the secretariats of the council of TV ads and the council of marketing and asked for a meeting. We brainstormed ideas and voted for the best ones. We opted for the making of stations (each one related to a specific product) to which delegates will be divided to create rough print ads, TV ads, and radio scripts given a time limit. Delegates would then rotate on the stations and secretariats would give points every time in order to decide upon a winner in the end.

3. Tell us about an occasion when you have taken the initiative to learn and develop yourself in significantly new ways. Why did you want to do this, what did you do and what was the result?(300 word limit imposed) *

Before joining the International Conference on Global Economy, I was terrified. The reason behind this was the fact that it was the first time I was given a high board position in a club. A lot of people counted on me, and I could not let them down. I still wanted to join because I thought the position would help me gain more confidence and grant me better presentation skills as well as organization and time management skills. My job was to teach radio and print advertisements, with co-secretariats, a group of 30 delegates. Since I love teaching, I applied for the program. When I got accepted, I was happy I was chosen among others to perform this job. As a result, I worked hard to meet the expectations of the club and I learned a lot about teamwork, whether the good or the bad side of it. I also developed myself in many ways. I became more confident and gained new skills.

4. Tell us about a time when you saw the opportunity to really make a difference for the future of an activity, team or organization. What did you do, what obstacles did you overcome, and what happened as a result? (300 word limit imposed) *

As a teenager, when I played in the Gezira Tennis Team, I was assigned an important position during the clubs League. The first time for me to be a part of it, the coach chose me to play a singles match, which was a huge responsibility. We were playing against El-Ahly club, which was a tough opponent. If I won my match, Gezira would have won the cup for the first time since many years. My opponent was Egypt's ranking number 1 at that time. It was very rare that anyone took even a few games from here, but my team still counted on me. I did not win this match. But I did my best and I lost with a final set, which means that I took an entire set from her, and many other games. Even though I lost, my match inspired a lot of people in the team this day, and the coach told them that if I could do such a good score with this girl, then it was still possible for us to win this League, if the others won their match. As he said, my team members tried their best, many of them won their matches due to our cheers, and we won the cup.
